Takeaways:

• Rev. Joshua shared that our worship experience has to be a high-quality experience if we expect people to stay and watch.





- Pastor Bankole shared that he spoke with his Church about how they approached the Sunday experience as a production and being mindful of the importance of each piece of the experience.
- Pastor Krystal shared that Churches need to find people committed to showing the Church in the best light of Christ to help them have a fully focused production team; these people can be volunteer staff.
- Pastor Krystal encouraged us to focus more on the content of Jesus to make a quality worship experience.
- A shorter worship experience is important, but the content and its relevance is most important in this season.

Final Takeaways:

- If you want your worship experience to be impactful for everyone who joins you, you need to be mindful of the quality of the experience. Take the time to plan out the experience and engage your worship team to work the plan together. If you haven't changed your online experience, now is the time.
- Use the equipment you have to record for Sunday and take the time you have, the 5 to 6 days before Sunday to record a quality experience for ALL age groups. Our Church has created YouTube channels for all of the age groups to deliver short and quick lessons for the students and parents.

- How have you changed your worship experience in this season?
- Do you have an offering for the students and other age groups of your church during this season? If not, who can you ask in your congregation or community to help you?
