- Dr. Bobby shares that it is important to pivot but we can't pivot too quickly, everyone won't go with us.
 - "Necessary turns should still be made cautiously"
- When you transition your Church from one place to another one, you need to have several of conversations and explain to people the why before you explain the what.
- Dr. Bobby had a clear plan for those who were new to the Church as well as for those who he believed would be joining.
- When people transition out of your Church the Lord is moving people out to make room for the people that you will need to move the Church forward.
- Dr. Bobby spent the time to allow his legacy members (longtime members) to know that he was honoring them with this name change and the Church transition.
- As a Church The Heights practiced good stewardship over their resources for several years in order to update and renovate the Church during the pandemic.
- Dr. Bobby shares that when hiring Gen Z on your staff understand that they don't want to give their life to your dream but want to use your dream to leverage their dreams.
